

- Continue drafting your essay
- Investigate universities
- Visit universities when possible
- Prior to G12, list your universities in Maia Learning under 'Universities Considering'
- Co-curriculars and super curriculars
- Finish your Extended Essay draft
- G11 IB Anticpated Grades (May) vs G12 PG (Oct)

Common Mistakes



Not doing research / not using resources
No interest demonstrated
No balance
Delusional - know the process
Waiting too long to take SAT/ELP, or no SAT/ELP

Common Mistakes



- Relying on a sibling/parent/ consultant (agents)/friend/teacher for advice
- Waiting too long to start writing and/or applying
- Not enough feedback
- Writing is key in highly selective admissions







1. Have all testing done before G12 starts, e.g. SAT, ELP, UCAT, etc.





2. Have your Extended Essay completed before G12 starts.





3. Get your writing done early! And then revise...and revise...and revise...and revise...and....





4. Get to know your teachers and counsellor really well. They write the letters that bring context to your application





5. Put yourself in control. Own it.
