



Academic Programs & Diploma Pathways

USA High School Diploma

AISG offers a USA High School Diploma accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). We offer a broad range of subjects across various disciplines allowing students to build an academic program tailored for their success. As of August 2023, AISG students in grades 9 and 10 complete the Middle Years Programme (MYP). Students entering 11 and 12 may choose to take IB courses and/or AISG high school courses.

IB Diploma Programme (IBDP)

AISG has been authorized to offer the IBDP since April 2004. In this pathway, the IBDP is offered alongside the USA High School Diploma, adhering to the minimum credit requirements. Over the course of two years, IBDP students must follow an approved program of courses distributed among six IB groups. Three of these courses must be taken at higher level (HL). IBDP candidates must research and write a 4,000-word Extended Essay (EE), complete the Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course, and fulfill the requirements for Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS).
