School and Community

Founded in 1981, the American International School of Guangzhou (AISG) is a private school offering university preparation in English for expatriate students. The class of 2012 has 60 students. All are expected to earn a US High School Diploma. Roughly 70% will also earn an IB Diploma. Total enrollment is 978. American 25%, Korean 17%, SAR Chinese 15%, Canadian 11%, all other 32%.

Accreditation & Faculty

AISG is accredited by the Association of Western Schools and Colleges, and is registered by The People's Republic of China as a School for Foreign Children. 99% of faculty are expatriate, most from North America (Bachelor's 33%, Master's 67%).

Calendar

The school year (188 days) has two semesters beginning in August and January. Classes meet for 90 minutes, every other day, Mon - Fri.

Course Offerings 2011/2012

GPA & Rank

Grades are reported using an A through F system. GPAs are computed using all subjects in which students are enrolled. AISG does not report class rank. Only courses taken at AISG are used in the calculation of a student's GPA. Students are limited to no more than 4 HL courses per year.

Graduation Requirements

One credit is awarded for each full year course completed with a passing mark (D- or above). One-half credit is awarded for one semester of passing work.
