### School and Community

The American International School of Guangzhou (AISG) is a non-profit, co-educational day school offering university preparation in English for expatriate students.

Founded in 1981, AISG is the oldest international school in South China. Total enrollment is 969 (American 23%, Korean 16%, SAR Chinese 16%, Canadian 11%, all other 34%).

Theclassof2014has74students. All are expected to earn a US High School Diploma. Roughly 75%willalsoearnanIBDiploma.

### **Accreditation & Faculty**

AISGisaccreditedbytheWestern Association of Schools and Colleges, and is registered by The People's Republic of China as a SchoolforForeignChildren.99% of faculty are expatriate, most fromNorthAmerica(Bachelor's 33%, Master's 67%).

### Calendar

The school year (188 days) has two semesters beginning in AugustandJanuary.Classesmeet for 85 minutes, every other day, Monday to Friday.

#### **GPA & Rank**

Grades are reported using an A through F system. GPAs are computed using all subjects in

which students are enrolled. AISG does not report class rank. Only courses taken at AISG are used in the calculation ofastudent's GPA. Students are limited to no more than 4 IB HL courses per year.

As part of the university applicationsprocess, we disclose casesofacademicdishonestyand serious disciplinary infractions when asked.

### **Graduation Requirements**

One credit is awarded for each fullyearcoursecompletedwitha passingmark(D-orabove).Onehalf credit is awarded for one semester of passing work.
